THE INTERNAL DRAINAGE BOARDS (FINANCE) REGULATIONS 1992

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN pursuant to Section 48 of the Land Drainage Act 1991 that at a meeting of the Board held on 21st January 2019 it was resolved:

1. that the proportions of the Board's expenditure for 2019/20 to be raised by Drainage Rates on agricultural land and buildings and by Special Levies on the local billing authorities be 22.62% (£241,748) and 77.38% (£827,220) respectively.
2. to make the Drainage Rates and Special Levies under the official seal of the Board as follows:

3. that the special levies due from the five billing authorities within the Board's area be fixed for the year ending 31st March 2020 as follows:
